

Retail Trade, November 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – January 20, 2023

The retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon for November 2022 were \$83.3 million, an increase of \$5.3 million, or 6.8%, compared to November 2021 (\$78.0 million). Yukon's November 2022 retail sales decreased by \$6.9 million, or 7.7%, compared to October 2022.

Nationally, retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 6.0% in November 2022 compared to November 2021, and increased 2.5% compared to October 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through November 2022), retail sales in Yukon totalled \$940.9 million, an increase of \$59.6 million, or 6.8%, compared to the same period in 2021 (\$881.3 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 8.2% over this time period.
