



Retail Trade, September 2022 (preliminary)

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The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of retail sales in Yukon for September 2022 was \$89.1 million, an increase of \$4.7 million, or 5.5%, compared to \$84.4 million for September 2021. September 2022 retail sales decreased by \$9.6 million, or 9.8%, compared to August 2022.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 6.8% in September 2022 compared to September 2021, and decreased 3.7% compared to August 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January through September 2022), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$768.4 million. This represents an increase of \$50.2 million, or 7.0%, compared to the same time period in 2021 (\$718.1 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 8.8% over this time period.
