



## Wholesale Trade, January 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – March 16, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for January 2022 was \$12.1 million. This represents an increase of \$2.1 million, or 21.6%, compared to January 2021, and an increase of \$1.6 million, or 14.7%, compared to December 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in January 2022 increased 15.5% compared to January 2021, and decreased 7.7% compared to December 2021.

On a **revised** annual basis, the 2021 wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$199.9 million. Yukon's 2021 annual wholesale sales increased \$47.0 million, or 30.7%, compared to 2020 (\$153.0 million). Canada's wholesale sales increased 14.5% in 2021.
