



Wholesale Trade, July 2022 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – September 16, 2022

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for July 2022 was \$19.5 million. This represents an increase of \$0.1 million, or 0.7%, compared to July 2021, and a decrease of \$3.9 million, or 17.0%, compared to June 2022.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in July 2022 increased 9.4% compared to July 2021, and decreased 12.0% compared to June 2022.

On a year-to-date basis (January to July 2022), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$128.8 million. This represents an increase of \$13.5 million, or 11.7%, compared to the revised figure for the same time period in 2021 (\$115.4 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 13.0% over this time period.
