

Labour Force Survey, April 2022

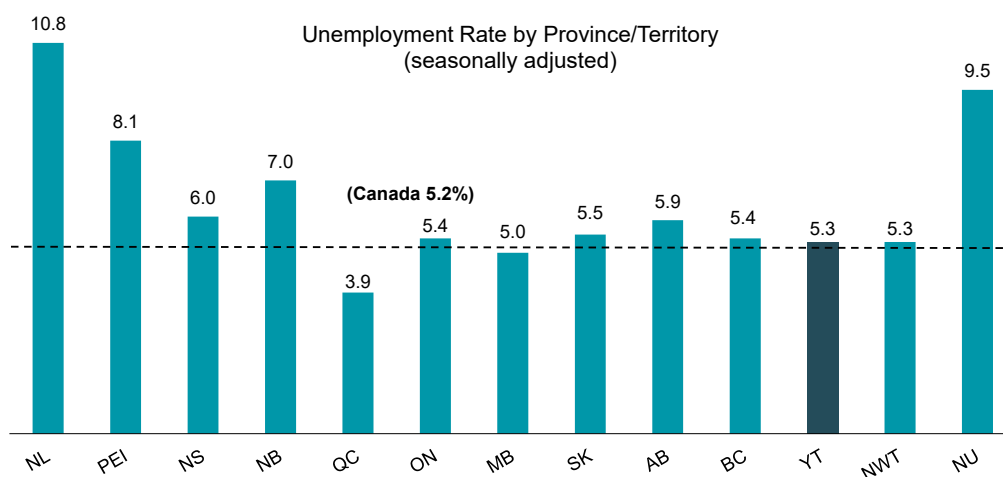
Released by Statistics Canada – May 6, 2022

In April 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.3%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 5.2%.

Compared to the figures for March 2022, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (24,500) increased by 500; the number of employed (23,200) increased by 600; and the number of unemployed (1,300) decreased by 100.
