

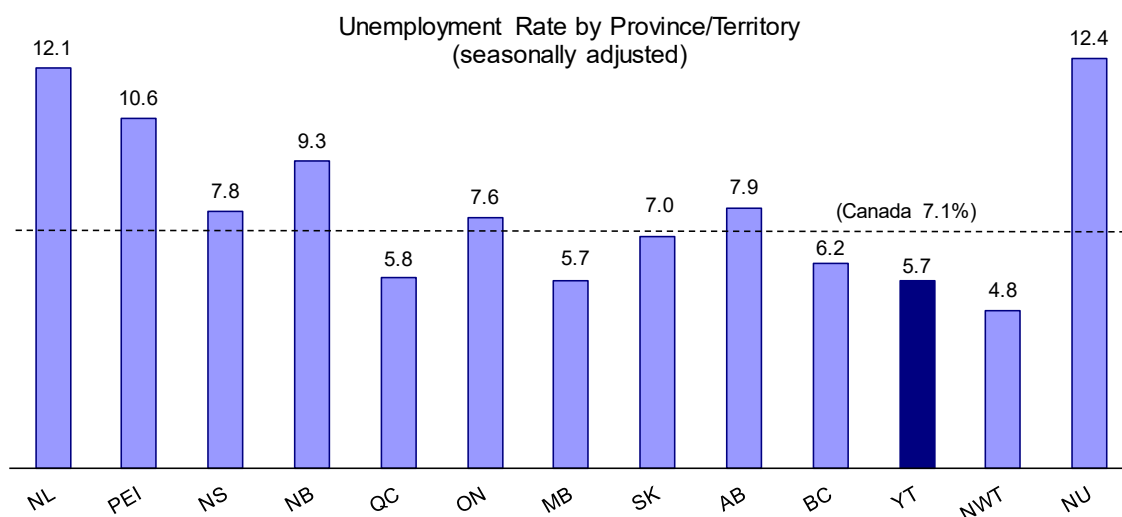
Labour Force Survey, August 2021

Released by Statistics Canada – September 10, 2021

In August 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.7%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 7.1%. Compared to the figures for July 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (22,900) decreased by 100; the number of employed (21,500) decreased by 100; and the number of unemployed (1,300) decreased by 100.
