

Labour Force Survey, January 2020

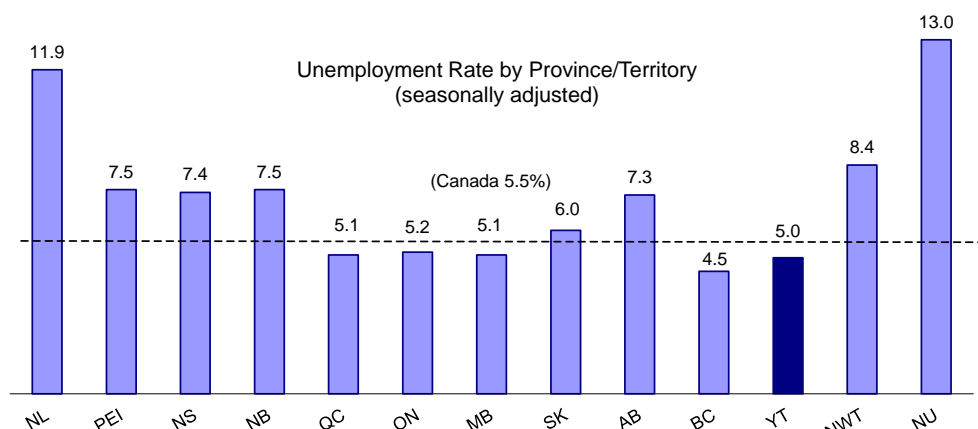

In January 2020, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.0%. Canada's unemployment rate for January was 5.5%. Compared to the figures for December 2019, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (22,200) increased by 100; the number of employed (21,200) increased by 100; and the number of unemployed (1,100) increased by 100.

Note: The number of employed plus unemployed may not equal the labour force figure due to rounding. Each January, Statistics Canada revises seasonally adjusted Labour Force Survey (LFS) figures for the previous three years. Numbers presented here reflect those revisions.

¹ All territories' monthly figures are based on three-month moving averages and are, therefore, not included in the overall figures for Canada.

² 'Change' is measured in percent, or percentage points, where applicable. Percentage points are the actual numerical difference between two percentages, such as: 10% - 8% = 2 percentage points.

³ All estimates are rounded to the nearest hundred.
