

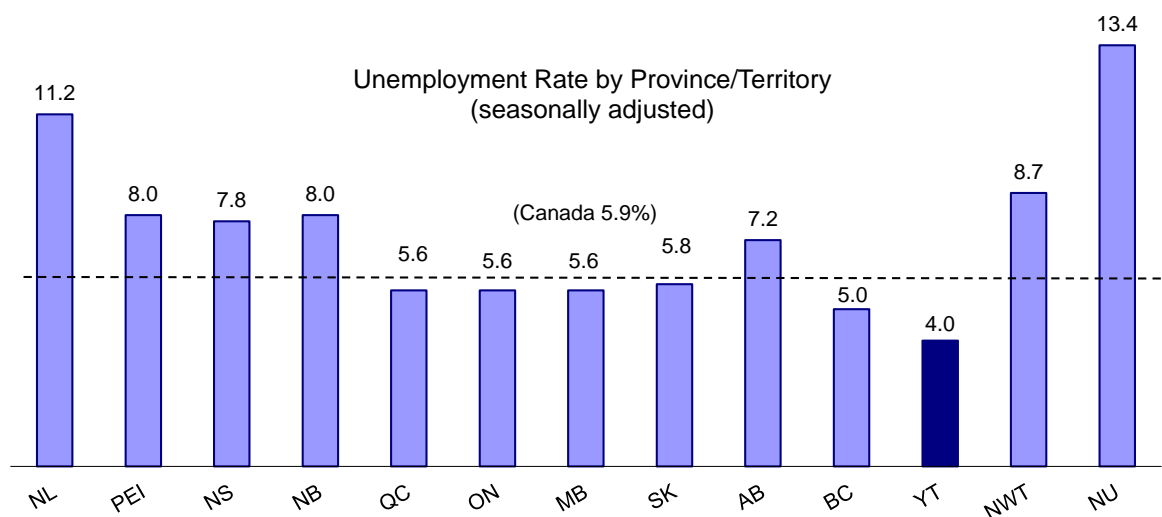
Labour Force Survey, November 2019

Released by Statistics Canada — December 6, 2019

In November 2019, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.0%. Canada's unemployment rate for November was 5.9%. Compared to the figures for October 2019, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (22,400) remained the same; the number of employed (21,500) decreased by 100; and the number of unemployed (900) increased by 200.
