

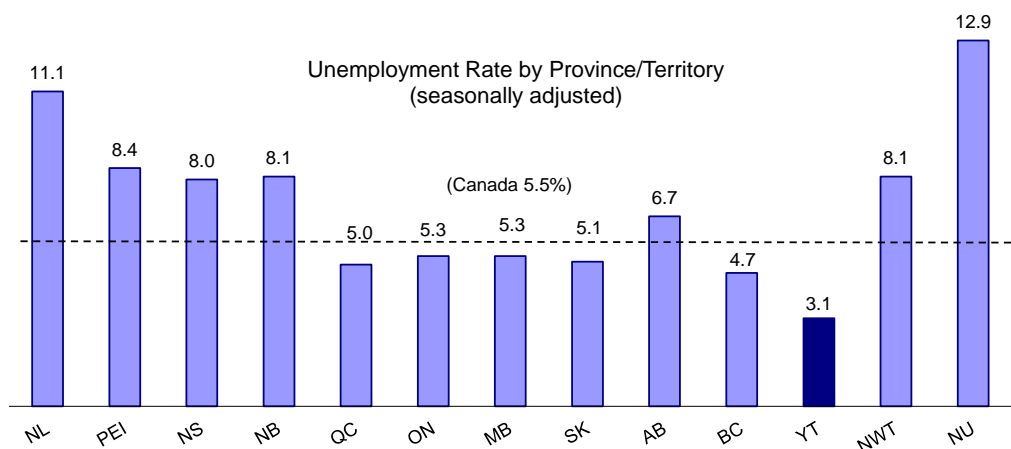
Labour Force Survey, October 2019

Released by Statistics Canada — November 8, 2019

In October 2019, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.1%. Canada's unemployment rate for October was 5.5%. Compared to the figures for September 2019, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (22,400) decreased by 200; the number of employed (21,600) decreased by 500; and the number of unemployed (700) increased by 100.

¹ All territories' monthly figures are based on three-month moving averages and are, therefore, not included in the overall figures for Canada.

² 'Change' is measured in percent, or percentage points, where applicable. Percentage points are the actual numerical difference between two percentages, such as: 10% - 8% = 2 percentage points.

³ All estimates are rounded to the nearest hundred.
