

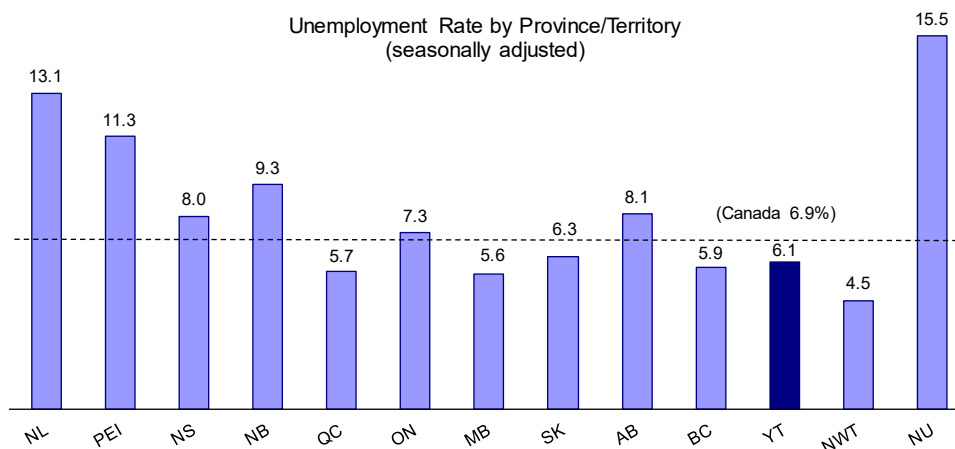
## Labour Force Survey, September 2021

Released by Statistics Canada – October 8, 2021

In September 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 6.1%. Canada's unemployment rate for the month was 6.9%. Compared to the figures for August 2021, Yukon's seasonally adjusted labour force (23,100) increased by 200; the number of employed (21,700) increased by 200; and the number of unemployed (1,400) increased by 100.
