



## Non-Profit Organizations and Volunteering Human Resource Module, 2019

Released by Statistics Canada — April 30, 2021

In 2019, Yukon's non-profit organizations (NPOs) — serving households, businesses and governments — employed 2,189 people. Compared to 2018, Yukon's NPO sector employment increased by 134 jobs, or 6.5%.

Nationally, NPOs jobs in 2019 increased by 2.6% compared to 2018.

Of the 2,189 NPOs jobs in Yukon: 77.3% were full-time and 22.7% were part-time; 28.2% were held by male employees and 71.8% by female employees.
