



Retail Trade, December 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – February 19, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for December 2020 was \$81.6 million, an increase of \$12.1 million, or 17.4%, compared to December 2019. The December 2020 retail sales figure increased by \$6.1 million, or 8.0%, compared to November 2020.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 4.5% in December 2020 compared to December 2019, and increased 2.1% compared to November 2020.

On a *preliminary* annual basis, retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$892.1 million. This represents an increase of \$26.7 million, or 3.1%, compared to 2019 (\$865.4 million). Canada's annual retail sales decreased 1.3% over this time period.
