Retail Trade, February 2021 (preliminary)

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The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for February 2021 was \$62.2 million, an increase of \$2.7 million, or 4.6%, compared to February 2020. Yukon's February 2021 retail sales decreased by \$1.5 million, or 2.4%, compared to January 2021.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 2.2% in February 2021 compared to February 2020, and increased 1.4% compared to January 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January through February 2021), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$126.0 million. This represents an increase of \$9.6 million, or 8.2%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$116.4 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 1.7% over this time period.

On a **revised** annual basis, retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$885.2 million in 2020. This represents an increase of \$19.7 million, or 2.3%, compared to 2019 (\$865.4 million). Canada's annual retail sales decreased 1.7% over this time period.
