

Retail Trade, January 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada — March 20, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for January 2020 was \$58.9 million, an increase of \$5.3 million, or 9.9%, compared to January 2019. The January 2020 retail sales figure decreased by \$11.3 million, or 16.1%, compared to December 2019.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 3.6% in January 2020 compared to January 2019, and decreased 19.6% compared to December 2019.

On a revised annual basis (January to December), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$863.8 million in 2019. This represents an increase of \$26.3 million, or 3.1%, compared to 2018 (\$837.5 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 1.6% over this time period.
