

Retail Trade, July 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – September 23, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for July 2021 was \$88.5 million, an increase of \$3.4 million, or 4.0%, compared to July 2020. Yukon's July 2021 retail sales increased by \$2.6 million, or 3.0%, compared to June 2021.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 5.2% in July 2021 compared to July 2020 and decreased 0.7% compared to June 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January through July 2021), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$538.2 million. This represents an increase of \$54.8 million, or 11.3%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$483.5 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 16.2% over this time period.
