



## Retail Trade, March 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada — May 22, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for March 2020 was \$66.8 million, a decrease of \$1.2 million, or 1.7%, compared to March 2019. The March 2020 retail sales figure increased by \$7.5 million, or 12.6%, compared to February 2020.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) decreased 10.9% in March 2020 compared to March 2019, and increased 1.2% compared to February 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January through March), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$184.8 million. This represents an increase of \$12.7 million, or 7.4%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$172.2 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales decreased 0.7% over this time period.
