

Retail Trade, November 2019 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada — January 24, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for November 2019 was \$68.7 million, an increase of \$1.0 million, or 1.5%, compared to November 2018. The November 2019 retail sales figure decreased by \$8.1 million, or 10.6%, compared to October 2019.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 1.6% in November 2019 compared to November 2018, and increased 1.0% compared to October 2019.

On a year-to-date basis (January to November), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$794.0 million. This represents an increase of \$26.5 million, or 3.5%, compared to the same time period in 2018 (\$767.5 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 1.5% over this time period.
