

Retail Trade, September 2019 *(preliminary)*

Released by Statistics Canada — November 22, 2019

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for September 2019 was \$73.7 million, a decrease of \$2.3 million, or 3.0%, compared to September 2018. The September 2019 retail sales figure decreased by \$10.0 million, or 12.0%, compared to August 2019.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) decreased 0.3% in September 2019 compared to September 2018, and decreased 7.1% compared to August 2019.

On a year-to-date basis (January to September), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$647.1 million. This represents an increase of \$17.8 million, or 2.8%, compared to the same time period in 2018 (\$629.3 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales increased 1.6% over this time period.
