

Retail Trade, September 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – November 20, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) for retail sales in Yukon for September 2020 was \$82.2 million, an increase of \$6.9 million, or 9.2%, compared to September 2019. The September 2020 retail sales figure decreased by \$1.2 million, or 1.4%, compared to August 2020.

Nationally, preliminary retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) increased 8.0% in September 2020 compared to September 2019, and increased 0.1% compared to August 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January through September), retail sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$653.2 million. This represents an increase of \$327,000, or 0.1%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$652.9 million). Canada's year-to-date retail sales decreased 3.9% over this time period.
