

Wholesale Trade, May 2021 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – July 16, 2021

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for May 2021 was \$19.3 million. This represents an increase of \$5.8 million, or 43.6%, compared to May 2020, and an increase of \$4.4 million, or 29.5%, compared to April 2021.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in May 2021 increased 37.3% compared to May 2020, and increased 2.8% compared to April 2021.

On a year-to-date basis (January to May), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$75.4 million. This represents an increase of \$17.3 million, or 29.8%, compared to the same time period in 2020 (\$58.1 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 20.5% over this time period.
