

Wholesale Trade, November 2019 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada — January 22, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for November 2019 was \$7.4 million. This represents a decrease of \$3.3 million, or 31.0%, compared to November 2018, and a decrease of \$3.5 million, or 31.9%, compared to October 2019.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in November 2019 decreased 1.8% compared to November 2018, and decreased 7.5% compared to October 2019.

On a year-to-date basis (January to November), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$143.0 million. This represents a decrease of \$50.6 million, or 26.1%, compared to the same time period in 2018 (\$193.6 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales increased 2.1% over this time period.
