

Wholesale Trade, September 2020 (preliminary)

Released by Statistics Canada – November 17, 2020

The preliminary estimate (seasonally unadjusted) of wholesale sales in Yukon for September 2020 was \$17.3 million. This represents an increase of \$865,000, or 5.3%, compared to September 2019, and an increase of \$426,000, or 2.5%, compared to August 2020.

Nationally, preliminary wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in September 2020 increased 7.2% compared to September 2019, and increased 7.1% compared to August 2020.

On a year-to-date basis (January to September), wholesale sales (seasonally unadjusted) in Yukon totalled \$125.4 million. This represents a decrease of \$1.0 million, or 0.8%, compared to the same time period in 2019 (\$126.5 million). Canada's year-to-date wholesale sales decreased 3.1% over this time period.
