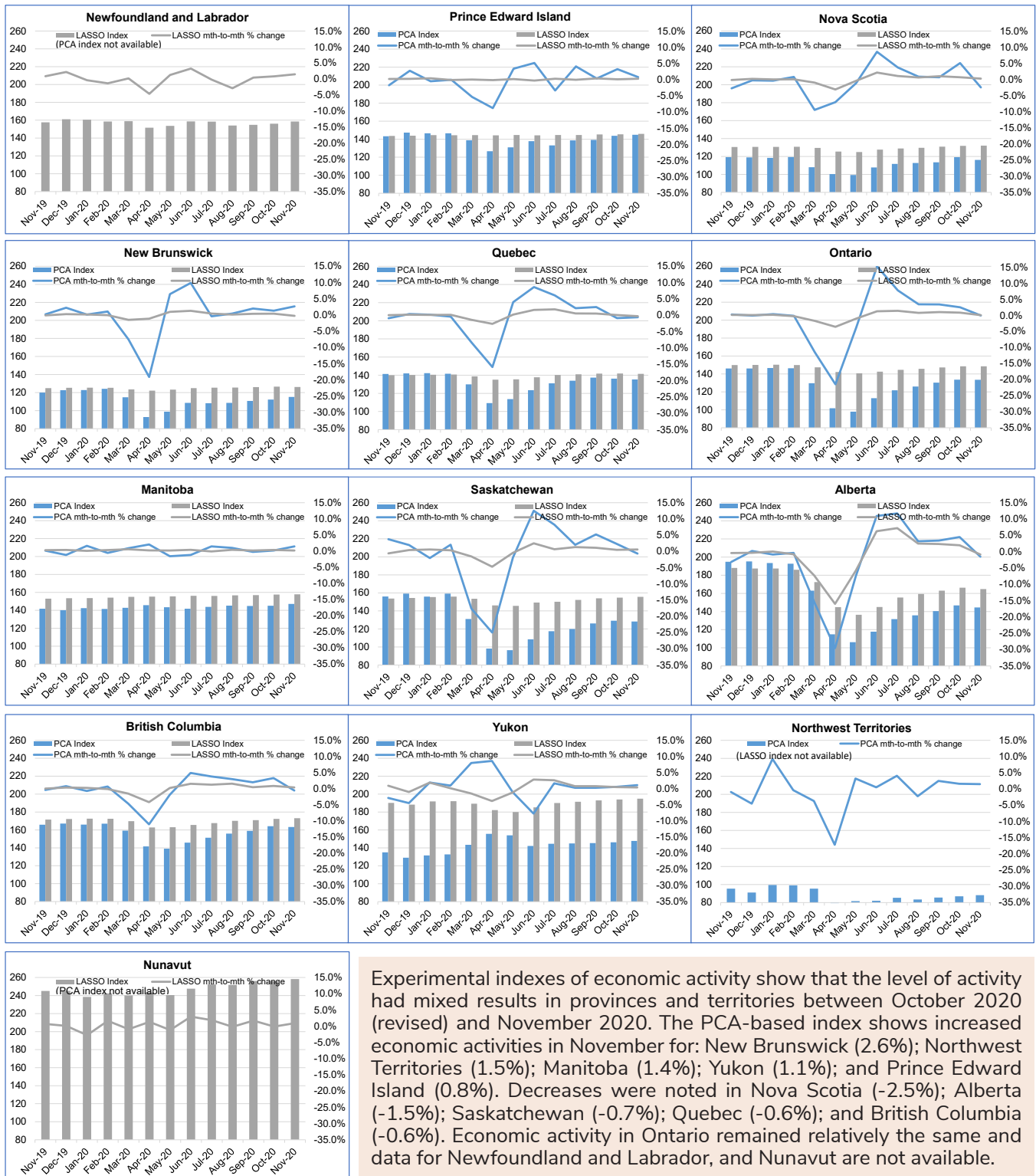




# Economic Activity Indexes (January 2002 = 100) and Month-to-month Changes, Provinces and Territories, November 2019 to November 2020



Experimental indexes of economic activity show that the level of activity had mixed results in provinces and territories between October 2020 (revised) and November 2020. The PCA-based index shows increased economic activities in November for: New Brunswick (2.6%); Northwest Territories (1.5%); Manitoba (1.4%); Yukon (1.1%); and Prince Edward Island (0.8%). Decreases were noted in Nova Scotia (-2.5%); Alberta (-1.5%); Saskatchewan (-0.7%); Quebec (-0.6%); and British Columbia (-0.6%). Economic activity in Ontario remained relatively the same and data for Newfoundland and Labrador, and Nunavut are not available.
