It is understood by the tenant that the tenant’s right to continue in occupancy is subject to the tenant divesting of the property identified above within 180 days from the first day of the month the tenant occupies their social housing unit.

If, after 180 days, a tenant has not given notice of divestment of the property, the Housing Manager will contact the tenant in writing to advise the divestment period has passed and the tenant must contact the office within 15 days in order to maintain their tenancy.

If the tenant does not provide reasonable grounds for not having disposed of the property, or does not contact the office after repeated attempts to contact the tenant, the Housing Manager will advise the Director of Housing Operations. A 30-day notice to terminate may be issued.

Yukon Housing Corporation reserves the right to extend the divestment period beyond 180 days but is not required to do so. Any extension to the divestment period will be limited to 180 days maximum per extension. There is no limit to the number of extensions Yukon Housing Corporation may choose to allow.
