## **Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board**

### **ITEM # 19-15**

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the application for Patrick Singh, operating as Paddy's Place, for a Liquor Primary – All Liquor Licence providing that all the requirements of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations have been met.

The Yukon Liquor Board denies the application for Patrick Singh, operating as Paddy's Place, for an Off Premises Liquor Licence based on Board Policy Manual tab 7 with respect to proximity targets:

- 1) Board Policy Manual tab 7 proximity target states, "*minimum of one-hundred and fifty (150) meters away from a public park, school, daycare, youth center, alcohol/treatment facility, existing off-sales licensee, YLC Store, or other areas considered by the board to pose a potential conflict, including those frequented by children, youth or other vulnerable persons.*" The board finds the application for off sales falls within the proximity of 2 licensed childcare centres.

This decision is based on the application as presented to board, and relevant sections of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations and board policy.
