**Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board**

**ITEM # 20-17**

The Yukon Liquor Board denies the application for 16714 Yukon Inc., operating as G&P Steakhouse for an Off Premises Liquor Licence based on board policy manual Off-Premises Liquor Licence tab 7, which states, “*minimum of one-hundred and fifty (150) meters away from a public park, school, daycare, youth center, alcohol/treatment facility, existing off-sales licensee, YLC Store, or other areas considered by the board to pose a potential conflict, including those frequented by children, youth or other vulnerable persons.*” The board finds the application for an Off Premises Liquor Licence falls within the proximity of 1 existing licensee who holds an off premises license.

This decision is based on the application as presented to board, and relevant sections of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations and board policy.
