## **Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board**

### **ITEM # 21-16**

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the application in principle for Lumel Studios Ltd., for a change to existing Food Primary – All Liquor licence, providing that all the requirements of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations have been met.

The Yukon Liquor Board denies the application in principle for Lumel Studios Ltd., operating as Lumel Studios Ltd., for an Off Premises Liquor licence based on board policy manual Off-Premises Liquor licence tab 7, which states, “minimum of one-hundred and fifty (150) meters away from a public park, school, daycare, youth center, alcohol/treatment facility, existing off-sales licensee, YLC Store, or other areas considered by the board to pose a potential conflict, including those frequented by children, youth or other vulnerable persons.” The board finds the application for off sales falls within the proximity of the Yukon Liquor Corporations Whitehorse liquor store and the Montessori Borealis School.

This decision is based on the application as presented to the board, and relevant sections of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations and board policy.
