

Chief Coroner calls Inquest into the death of Angelo Sebastian Fully EVANS

July 28, 2026 – A Coroner's Inquest into the death of Angelo Sebastian Fully EVANS has been called by Chief Coroner Heather Jones. The date and location for the inquest have yet to be determined.

The death of EVANS was reported to Yukon Coroner's Service on January 26, 2026, and he is believed to have died in hospital in Dawson City.

A presiding coroner and a jury will hear evidence from witnesses under oath to determine the facts surrounding this death. The jury will have the opportunity to make recommendations aimed at preventing deaths under similar circumstances. A jury must not make any finding of legal responsibility or express any conclusion of law.

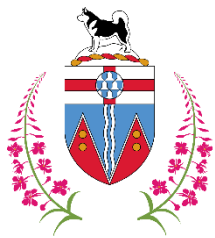
Under Section 40(1) of the Coroner's Act, the Chief Coroner may direct that an inquest be held when the public has an interest in being informed of the circumstances surrounding the death and when an inquest would bring dangerous practices to the knowledge of the public and facilitate the making of recommendations to avoid preventable deaths.

A Coroner's Inquest is a public inquiry that serves three primary functions:

1. to determine the facts related to a death, including the identity of the deceased and how, when, where and by what means the individual came to their death, as well as a classification for the death;
2. to make recommendations, where appropriate and supported by evidence, to prevent deaths in similar circumstances; and
3. to ensure public confidence that the circumstances surrounding the death of an individual will not be overlooked, concealed or ignored.
