REMARKS:

Yukon Coroner's Service has been able to confirm the identity of the human remains found in the Long Lake area of Whitehorse on May 22 to be 59 year-old Kenneth ALGAR. It was reported that Mr. ALGAR was last seen leaving Whitehorse General Hospital on the evening of September 3, 2017. Medical records helped to confirm identity and foul play is not suspected at this time. An autopsy will be held at Vancouver General Hospital next week as Yukon Coroner's Service continues our investigation.

Mr. ALGAR was a longtime resident of Whitehorse and a citizen of the Na-Cho Nyak Dun First Nation.
