REMARKS:

Yukon Coroners Service together with assistance from Teslin RCMP, have been investigating the death of a male motorcyclist who died near km 1320 of the Alaska Highway on Sunday June 11.

The deceased has been identified as 64 year-old J. Michael GRAY of Fairbanks, Alaska. Mr. Gray had left Fairbanks early on June 10 and was enroute to a family gathering in Montana. He was traveling in a construction zone south of Jake's Coroner when he lost control of his motorcycle in the gravel on the shoulder of the highway. The accident occurred shortly after 11 a.m.

Yukon Coroners Service extends condolences to the family and friends of Mr. GRAY.
