Re: Unsupervised Electrical Installations

It has come to our attention that electrical installations or portions of electrical installations are being done without the supervision of a qualified electrician on site.

In reference to the Yukon Electrical Protection Act 14(5):

- No person who is not a qualified electrician shall perform electrical work to which this Act applies except as an assistant to and under the continuous supervision of a qualified electrician engaged on the same piece of work.

Some common examples of the above are:

- 1. Apprentices working alone
- 2. Homeowners assisting an electrician on their project
- 3. Excavation contractors backfilling underground electrical installations

Please ensure there is a qualified electrician on site while any part of the electrical work under your permit is being completed.
