

Ministerial Authorization for End-of-Year School Events

DEPARTMENT: Community Services

AUTHORITY: *Civil Emergency Measures Health Protection (COVID-19) Order (Civil Emergency Measures Act)*

SECTION: Subsection 9.1(1)

ORIGINAL ORDER: Section 5 - Not more than 10 persons may congregate in the same place, except when they are congregating in the place where they all reside.

REASON FOR AUTHORIZATION: I am granting approval for doing the following things that would otherwise not be permitted under section 5 of the *Civil Emergency Measures Health Protection (COVID-19) Order*.

AUTHORIZATION: End-of-Year School Events:


Any school in Yukon may hold an end-of-year event exceeding the current organized gathering numbers as long as the plan for a school's event is approved by the Covid Response Unit prior to it commencing and the gathering guidelines of the Chief Medical Officer of Health, as amended from time-to-time, are followed.

For greater certainty:

- Masking requirements under the *Civil Emergency Measures Act - Masks in Indoor Public Spaces (COVID-19) Order* must be followed.
- The event space must allow for physical distancing and the observation of all other public health recommendations and orders.
- No event will exceed 500 attendees.

REASONS FOR CHANGE: Provide some relief from measures that affect the daily lives of Yukoners and move into the next phase of recovery.
