AUTHORIZATION: Outdoor gatherings:

> As long as guidelines of the Chief Medical Officer of Health, as amended from time-to-time, are followed:

• up to 100 persons may gather outdoors at a social gathering.

• up to 200 persons may gather outdoors at an organized event.

Indoor gatherings:

As long as guidelines of the Chief Medical Officer of Health, as amended from time-to-time, are followed:

- up to 20 persons may gather indoors at a social gathering.
- at an organized event, the number of persons who may gather in the indoor place is the number that can gather while maintaining 2 meters of physical distancing in that place or 200 persons, whichever is less.

For greater certainty, masking requirements under the Civil Emergency Measures Act - Masks in Indoor Public Spaces (COVID-19) Order must be followed.

REASONS FOR CHANGE:

Focus on long-term sustainability, while monitoring effects of changes to protect the health of Yukoners as we learn to live with COVID-19.

Continue to empower the commercial, government and social sectors to reopen or continue operating safely, protecting the health of workers and members of the public receiving services.
