

## Ministerial Authorization for Restaurants to Offer Dine-In Service

DEPARTMENT: Community Services

AUTHORITY: *Civil Emergency Measures Health Protection (COVID-19) Order*

SECTION: subsection 9.1(1)

ORIGINAL ORDER: s. 6 Every owner or manager of, or employee who works at, a restaurant, cafe or other eating or drinking place, within the meaning of the *Eating or Drinking Places Regulations*, must ensure that any food or drink that is sold or otherwise provided to a member of the public at that place is not consumed at that place.

REASON FOR AUTHORIZATION: I am granting approval for doing the following things that would otherwise not be permitted under section 6 of the *Civil Emergency Measures Health Protection (COVID-19) Order*.


AUTHORIZATION: Every owner or manager of, or employee who works at, a restaurant, cafe or other eating or drinking place, within the meaning of the *Eating or Drinking Places Regulations*, may offer dine-in services at 100% capacity, as long as:

1. they have an Operational Plan related to COVID-19 approved by the Health Emergency Operations Centre or the COVID Response Unit at the Department of Health and Social Services; and
2. they follow the guidelines set out by the Chief Medical Officer of Health, as may be amended from time-to-time, including guidelines on the collection of contact information.

For greater certainty, masking requirements under the *Civil Emergency Measures Act - Masks in Indoor Public Spaces (COVID-19) Order* must be followed.

REASON FOR CHANGE: To empower the commercial, government and social sectors to reopen or continue operating safely, protecting the health of employees returning to work and members of the public receiving services.
