
Did you know?

If you have experienced domestic violence or sexualized violence, or if you are supporting a child, family member, intimate partner, or close friend who is the victim of domestic or sexualized violence, you have the right to paid and unpaid time off.



- Give as much notice as possible
- If an employer requires an employee to submit a form, a standard form is available so only the critical information is recorded
- Employers MUST ensure confidentiality and should not share the form or any information about the applicant unless absolutely required, such as with payroll
- Employees DO NOT need to provide proof

- Get counselling
- To move or relocate
- To get legal help
- To support a child, family member, intimate partner, or close friend who is the victim of domestic or sexualized violence
