

How to build a sandbag berm



- 1. Fill sandbags 60 percent full.
- 2. Build your berm at the highest, driest point closest to your home. Do not build on decks, patios, fences, planters, gardens or any other platform.
- 3. Dig a trench one bag deep and two bags wide.
- 4. Build the bottom layer of the berm. Overlap the empty part of each sandbag with the full part of the next bag.
- 5. Carefully walk on sandbags to secure them in place.
- 6. Build more layers, placing each layer of sandbags in alternating directions. The berm should be triangle-shaped. The base should be wider than the height.
- 7. Use a poly sheet to waterproof the side facing the water. Secure the top and bottom of the sheet with sandbags.



How to fill a sandbag



Use sandbags to help protect your property against floods.

To fill a sandbag:

- 1. Hold the sandbag open. If you're filling sandbags alone, insert a hoop in the mouth of the sandbag to hold it open.
- 2. Use a shovel to fill the sandbag with sand.
- 3. Only fill sandbags 60% full.
- 4. Close the sandbag with a twist tie or rope.
