### Definitions

#### Full-time post-secondary studies:

You're in full-time post-secondary studies if you're taking 60% of a full course load (or 40% or more if you're a student with a permanent disability or, a persistent or prolonged disability).

**Permanent disability** is a functional limitation that is

- caused by a physical or mental impairment that restricts your ability to perform the daily activities necessary to participate in studies at a post-secondary level or in the labour force, and
- expected to remain with you for your expected life.

**Persistent or Prolonged disability** is a functional limitation that is

- caused by a physical, mental, intellectual, cognitive, learning, communication or sensory impairment that restricts the ability of a person to perform the daily activities necessary to pursue studies at a post-secondary school level or to participate in the labour force and
- has lasted, or is expected to last, for a period of at least 12 months

**Note:** Students with a Permanent Disability or a Persistent or Prolonged Disability who are taking between 40% and 59% of a full-time course load have a choice to be considered full-time or part-time.
