

Canada-Yukon Canadian Agricultural Partnership Funding Fiscal Year End Report 2018-19

The Canadian Agricultural Partnership provides funding to help Yukon agriculture:

- increase competitiveness, productivity or profitability;
- increase environmental sustainability;
- expand domestic and international markets; and
- improve the anticipation, mitigation and response to risks.

Project costs include the applicant's commitment to the projects as well as any additional funding from other sources.
