



FORESTRY PROGRAM SUPPORT - APPLICATION

Program objectives and overview

The Forestry Support Program provides financial support to commercial timber harvesters and fuel wood retailers. The objectives of the program are to help businesses overcome barriers to efficient and safe operations, and to contribute to the provision of a stable timber product supply for the Yukon.

Successful applicants can purchase goods or services in support of their work and be refunded a percentage of the costs: commercial timber harvesters¹ and retailers² can apply for a total amount between \$750 and \$15,000, as per Table 1.

Application period April 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024

Eligibility

- Recipients for the Forestry Support Program must be Yukon commercial timber harvesting or firewood retailer businesses.
- Recipients must have a [Yukon Corporate Registry](#) number that is valid for the application period.
- Commercial harvesters must be up to date with reporting at the date of application.
- Commercial harvesters must be clear of debt under the *Forest Resources Act*.
- Proof of purchase receipts must be provided in order to receive funds.

Available funds

Harvester category	Percentage reimbursed (Not including GST)	Maximum \$ available per applicant
1-3	100%	\$ 750
4	75%	\$ 7,500
5	75%	\$ 15,000

Category 1 - 3 recipients (including retailers) will be eligible for up to **100 per cent reimbursement, up to a total of \$750** on the local purchase, repair or upgrade of the following:

- harvest equipment;
- work vehicles (including trailer);
- safety equipment; and
- environmental protection equipment (e.g., fuel spill kits, fire prevention equipment).

Category 4 recipients will be eligible for up to **75 per cent reimbursement, up to a total of \$7,500** on the local purchase, repair or upgrade of the following:

- harvest equipment;
- work vehicles (including trailer);
- safety equipment;
- environmental protection equipment (e.g. fuel spill kits, fire prevention equipment);
- planning costs³; and
- administration⁴ costs.

1 The Forest Management Branch has established categories for timber harvesters, defined by typical harvest volumes (i.e. past performance) per the Commercial Timber Harvest Allocation Procedure.

4 Income tax or accounting support

Category 5 recipients will be eligible for up to **75 per cent reimbursement, up to a total of \$15,000** on the local purchase, repair or upgrade of the following:

- harvest equipment;
- work vehicles (including trailer);
- safety equipment;
- environmental protection equipment (e.g. fuel spill kits, fire prevention equipment);
- planning costs³; and
- administration⁴ costs.

Ineligible costs

Funds cannot be used for:

- GST - general sales tax;
- maintenance or purchase of personal vehicles of any kind;
- fuel, oil or other consumables;
- labour costs; and
- any goods or services that are being funded by other Government of Yukon programs.

Note: Applications for goods or services that are not listed here will be reviewed by the Program Manager to determine eligibility.

Distribution of funds

- Once applications are deemed complete, approval or rejection will be determined and communicated within three weeks.
- Communication will take place in the form requested by the applicant (e.g. email, phone or mail).
- Money paid for the Forestry Support Program will be based on corresponding proof of purchase receipts for the eligibility period: approved program applicants will receive their rebate within four weeks of receiving receipts.
- An eligible recipient of the Forestry Support Program may not receive more than the amount identified in Table 1.
- All applications will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Applications will be accepted until program funds are spent or until March 31, 2024.
