

In November of 1998, the federal government transferred responsibility for oil and gas to Yukon. The Yukon Oil and Gas Act came into effect at that time. Within the Act you will find the Oil & Gas Disposition Regulations that set out the "Land Division System" dividing Yukon into grid areas.

A "Grid Area" is divided into 80 equal sections between latitudes 60 and 68.


A "Grid Area" is divided into 60 equal sections between latitudes 68 and 70.




Grid Areas:
