Before you apply

Eligibility

1. Eligible recipients for the timber harvesting incentive must be Yukon-registered commercial timber harvesting businesses. You must have a Yukon Corporate Registry number through [Corporate Affairs](#) that is valid for the application period.
2. The following are not eligible for the timber harvesting incentive:
 - timber harvested under a Yukon government contract including but not limited to fuel abatement projects, land clearing, right-of-way establishment or maintenance and campground wood supply;
 - timber harvested on mining claims;
 - timber on agriculture land (agreement for sale or lease);
 - timber harvested on Settlement Land;
 - timber harvested on private land; and
 - commercial suppliers, who purchase timber from a commercial timber harvesting business and re-sell the purchased timber.
3. Applications that detail scenarios that have not been described will be reviewed by the Director of the Forest Management Branch to determine eligibility.
4. To qualify for the timber harvest incentive, forest resources harvest reporting must be current at the date of application.
5. Commercial harvesters will not be eligible for the timber harvesting incentive if they are in arrears under the *Forest Resources Act*.
6. Proof of purchase receipts including the name and contact information of the purchaser for timber harvested under a fuel wood licence may be requested, at the Director's discretion.
7. The timber harvesting incentive timeframe is between **April 1, 2023 and March 31, 2024**.

Distribution of funds

8. Money paid for the timber harvesting incentive is based on harvest reporting and, where applicable, corresponding proof of purchase receipts for the 2023-2024 fiscal year.
9. If the combined amounts paid out for the timber harvesting incentive exceeds the maximum allocated funding available for this initiative, then applications will be discontinued due to fund exhaustion.
10. Any volume harvested by a commercial harvester that exceeds the amount of volume permitted to them will not be considered for funding purposes.
11. An eligible recipient of the timber harvesting incentive may not receive more than \$10 per cubic metre, (\$22.65 per cord).
12. All applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.
