We asked you to share your input on how we should observe time in Yukon.

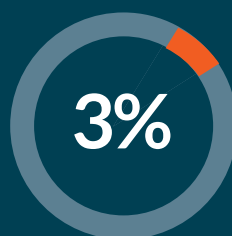
We received

97% of responses came from citizens



3% of responses came from businesses and organizations

Should Yukon end the twice annual seasonal time change?

# 93%

supported ending the practice

For those who wanted to end seasonal time change:



want to stay on Pacific Daylight Saving Time year-round



25% want to stay on Pacific Standard Time year-round



5% had no preference

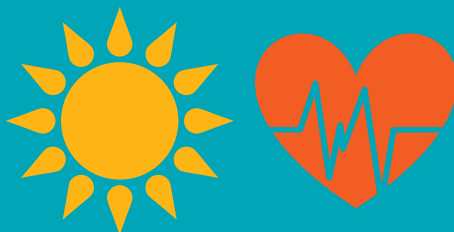
