Conversation classes:

Let's Speak French !

Course description by level

Beginner (1, 2, 3 and 4)

This level is for people who:

- have never studied French, or who
- have studied French in the past but have forgotten the basics.

Goals for this level include:

- greeting people, introducing yourself, talking about yourself and your family;
- understanding and using basic French notions: pronunciation, question and negative sentences, simple verb tenses, etc.;
- acquiring enough vocabulary to participate in a simple conversation in French.

Advanced

This level is for people who:

- have a strong knowledge of French;
- want to continue developing their oral and written skills.

Goals for this level include:

- incorporating intermediate level notions;
- acquiring a rich, nuanced vocabulary on a variety of topics;
- using complex grammatical and verbal structures to fully participate in various communication situations.

Intermediate (1, 2, 3 and 4)

This level is for people who:

- have a basic knowledge or a reasonably good understanding of French;
- can use French in everyday situations.

Goals for this level include:

- incorporating beginner-level concepts;
- expanding vocabulary;
- increasing knowledge of grammar: different verb tenses (imperfect, simple future, conditional), pronominal verbs, prepositions of place, and more;
- clearly communicating in most settings with oral and written French.

Consolidation

This level is for people who:

- are at an advanced level and wish to maintain it;
- want to expand their vocabulary and be exposed to different kinds of French.

Goals for this level include:

- reviewing complex grammar;
- improving oral and written fluency in various situations;
- adapting your register and vocabulary in different communication contexts.

Weekly classes

Format

Twelve weekly classes, each one 2 hours.
Offered in the fall (from September to December)
and in the winter (from January to April).
