## KNOW THE RISKS

Codeine belongs to a group of pain medications called narcotic analgesics. Codeine is an opioid that acts on the central nervous system to relieve mild to moderate pain.

Codeine can make you drowsy. Do not drive or operate a motor vehicle as you may be legally impaired.

Fatal side effects can occur if you use opioid medicine with alcohol, or with other medications that cause drowsiness or slow your breathing.

- Promethazine (cough medicine)
- Phenergan (w/ codeine)
