


COVID-19 Vaccine Boosters and 3rd Doses

While booster doses and 3rd doses for COVID-19 may seem similar, they actually have very different purposes.

Booster dose

A **booster dose is given as immunity may decrease over time**. A booster dose helps you maintain and lengthen your protection against COVID-19.



For people who received the Janssen vaccine, only 1 dose is needed to be fully immunized.

Who is a booster dose for?

Everyone 12 years of age and older will be invited to get a booster dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, 6 months after their initial series is complete (i.e. 2 or 3 doses)




Which vaccine is recommended for a booster dose?

- If you are between the ages of 12-29, the booster dose will be given with Pfizer vaccine.
- If you are 30 years of age or older, the booster dose will be given with Moderna vaccine.
- It is safe for your booster dose to be a different brand than your previous vaccines.

3rd dose

Some people, like people with **compromised immune systems**, need 3 doses to achieve the level of protection that most people get with 2 doses.



Who is a 3rd dose for?

A 3rd dose is recommended for people with **moderate to severely compromised immune systems** such as those receiving active cancer treatment. See the full list on Yukon.ca [yukon.ca](https://www.yukon.ca) or speak to a health care provider.



Which vaccine is recommended for a 3rd dose?

- If you are between the ages of 5-29, the third dose will be given with Pfizer vaccine.
- If you are 30 years of age or older, the third dose will be given with Moderna vaccine.
- It is safe for your third dose to be a different brand than your previous vaccines.
