



YUKON HEALTH CARE INSURANCE PLAN NOTIFICATION OF EXTENDED ABSENCE

Who should use this form?

- Yukon residents who have valid Yukon Health Care Insurance and will be absent from the territory for six months or more.

When should you report your absence from Yukon?

- When you leave temporarily to attend full-time studies at an accredited educational facility and intend to return upon completion of your studies. *You must provide your graduation date and confirm full-time enrollment every year.*
- When you are away for the purpose of vacation or work for more than six months (180 days).
- When you are away on an employment contract outside of Canada for a maximum of 24 months.

Important: Report your return from an extended absence

You must advise Insured Health and Hearing Services upon your return from any extended absence from Yukon. This is to ensure your continued eligibility for Yukon Health Care Insurance. See the [Return from Extended Absence form \(YG form #6897\)](#).

What address is required?

While away from the territory you should provide a phone number, email address or mailing address where we can contact you. When you return to the territory from an extended absence you must confirm your Yukon address with Insured Health Services.

Important			
Residents should be aware that their Yukon health care coverage may not pay for all the health care costs incurred outside the Yukon, and Canada. Ground and air ambulance services are not insured services under the <i>Canada Health Act</i> and are not covered by inter-provincial/territorial reciprocal agreements.			
The cost of these expenses while outside of Yukon is not covered by the Yukon Health Care Insurance Plan, and for this reason, residents are strongly advised to purchase additional health insurance from a private insurer before leaving the territory, whether they are going to another part of Canada or outside the country.
