## Subject: COVID- Mass Immunization Guidance Documents

## Dear Colleagues:

As Influenza immunization start dates are quickly approaching, please see guidance documents supporting mass immunization clinics. These guidelines should be used in conjunction with existing guidance documents surrounding mass clinics available at: <u>https://yukon.ca/en/health-and-wellness/health-concerns-diseases-and-conditions/find-information-health-professionals</u>

We are also starting the process of moving to stand-alone PPE Guidance and stand-alone COVID-19 screening questions to better support application of consistent guidance for various settings. The PPE documents for Community Health Centres and Medical Clinics/Outpatient Facilities will be updated shortly.

The following clinical guidance documents are new:

- Guidance and principles for extended use/re-use of surgical/procedural masks, for applicable settings only.
- Mask re-use guidelines 'How to's (October 8, 2020)
  - Pictorial step-by-step direction for how to remove or put on a mask it the same day.

We recognize the complexity and challenges that have been a part of this within the pandemic context and appreciate all the hard work that has gone into this year's influenza immunization campaign.
