To parents, guardians, students and staff of Three H Preschool Daycare – Hawkins location, Yukon Communicable Disease Control (YCDC) has been made aware of an additional positive case of COVID-19 at Three H Preschool Daycare, located at 102-205 Hawkins Street, on the following dates:

- December 27th, 29th and 30th (formerly December 27th and 29th only)

All staff and students who attended or worked at the above location on these dates have been identified as close 'contacts' of COVID-19. YCDC has completed a careful risk assessment and the clinical care direction for students and staff attending or working in the above classes is:

- A. self-isolate until January 6th, inclusive, and self-monitor for symptoms through January 13th, if:
 - you are not fully immunized to COVID-19 (as described below in Section B).
- B. self-monitor for symptoms through January 13th, if:
 - you are not significantly immunosuppressed due to illness or medication; AND
 - have received 2 doses of COVID-19 immunization, with the 2nd dose received after June 27th, and before December 13th; OR
 - have received 3 doses (2 doses + 1 booster) of COVID-19 immunization before December 13th; OR
 - you have been diagnosed with lab confirmed COVID-19 in the last 90 days.

It is very important that if any symptoms develop, no matter how mild, you do not go to work or school and arrange for testing. COVID-19 is a respiratory illness that is spread through droplets when a person coughs, speaks, or touches surfaces contaminated by the virus and then touches their face before washing their hands.

Symptoms to self-monitor for include:

Symptoms of COVID-19 may be mild or severe and often have a different presentation in persons who are very young or older persons. While most people will experience mild illness, older adults and people with pre-existing medical conditions are at higher risk for severe illness.
