
Syphilis is widespread in the Yukon and on the rise.

Case counts include all cases of syphilis (infectious, non-infectious, congenital, and unspecified duration), whereas the rate is calculated using infectious counts only. Data is current as of January 1, 2024.




In 2023, rates of infectious syphilis were over **26 times** higher than rates in 2019.

Most people infected are 20-39 years old

In 2023:

54% of syphilis cases in the Yukon were in women.

46% of syphilis cases in the Yukon were in men.
