An autopsy was performed at Vancouver General Hospital on July 27, 2015. The autopsy revealed blunt head and abdominal trauma. In particular, there were multiple external blunt injuries involving the head, torso, and extremities.

<u>Circumstances of Death</u>
Willis Cinnamon was a 56 year old male who was riding his motorcycle near the community of Beaver Creek, Yukon on July 18, 2015.
Mr. Cinnamon was involved in a single vehicle accident. He sustained life threatening injuries as a result of the accident and died on July 18, 2015.
Significant Factors/Conclusions
Mr. Cinnamon died as a result of blunt head and abdominal trauma. He was not wearing a helmet at the time of the accident.
